IRC Update Program

The new 2009 Codes are in effect. Are you prepared?

PROGRAM:

The Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry has updated the state's building code to the 2009 IRC as of January 1, 2010.

This program is intended to help builders, code officials, design professionals, remodelors, trades and other involved in the residential construction industry prepare for the new 2009 IRC. - Deck ledger attachments requirements
- Wall construction and wall bracing
- Completely re-written energy requirements
- Residential sprinklers
- Mechanical, plumbing, and electrical changes
